The applicant is responsible to ensure emergency vehicles and residents within the boundary of the closure are permitted access, as necessary.

Street barricades must be picked up before 2:00 p.m., at the Municipal Service Center, 925 S. Sixth St., the day before the block party (if the block party is on Saturday or Sunday, the barricades must be picked up the Friday before the date of the block party). Barricades must be returned by 2:00 p.m. to the Municipal Service Center the day after the block party (Monday if the block party is on a Friday or Saturday).

Sec. 146-10. Noises created by Human Behavior.

- (a) No person may create, assist in creating, permit, continue or permit the continuance of any unreasonably loud, disturbing, or unnecessary noise as may tend to annoy, inconvenience, disturb or cause discomfort to any person, or to the comfortable enjoyment of property.
- (b) No person occupying or having charge of any building or premises shall cause, suffer or allow any loud, excessive or unusual noise in the operation or use of any sound making or reproducing device so that such loud, excessive or unusual noise disturbs the comfort, quiet or repose of persons therein or in the vicinity.

PERMIT NOISE REQUIREMENTS

- Any amplified sound shall be maintained at a reasonable level and shall not interfere with others' enjoyment of the neighborhood.
- After 10:00 p.m. the noise level shall be turned down or off to minimize the disruption to the neighborhood.
- Neighbors that may be impacted by the event should be notified in advance by the permit holder to advise them of the event and to address any concerns that may arise.
- An adult (18 years or older) will be available on-site during the event and will be responsible for monitoring/managing the event and associated activities.
- Officers will monitor the area and may stop to assess volume and disruption to the neighborhood.
- The permit holder should contact the police department (920 339-4078) for any questions or concerns leading up to or during the event.
